Biogas Facility Establishment:

Within the JKKMIHSCP campus, there are preparations underway for the establishment of a biogas plant. This initiative aims to transform waste materials into valuable bio-fertilizer. Additionally, biogas generated from food waste serves as a sustainable energy source for cooking purposes.

Biogas plant

JKKMIHSCP campus has planned to erect a biogas plant that will help convert wastes into bio-fertilizer. Biogas obtained from food waste is used for cooking.

Food waste collection

Food waste obtained from the canteen, guest houses, and hostel is being collected separately using bins placed in each place which is sent to the poultry farm.

Segregation of non-degradable waste

Non-degradable wastes are being collected and it is stored in separate rooms for segregation.

Sewage treatment plant

Sewage water is treated, and recycled, and the treated water is used for watering the gardens and lawns maintained in the campus.
